



## **2010-2011 Fundraising Overview**

The KBLHC Board of Directors has set a fundraising goal of \$70,000 for the 2010-2011 season. The \$70,000 is needed to supplement the established 2010-2011 ice fee rates. Each level of pay will be assigned to a specific fundraising event in which all players/families at that level are required to volunteer and participate in the organization of their event.

### **Komet Ad Book – (Program Coordinated by PeeWee Families)**

Each family is required to sell the equivalent of 1 full page ad with the monetary amount equal to \$500. By obtaining at least 1 full page (OR ¼ pages, or ½ pages to make up a full page) your \$100 post dated volunteer check will be returned at the end of the season **and** your skater will receive a \$250 credit to his/her account. If you sell less than the equivalent of a full page ad, your \$100 check will be kept and deposited. For every ad sold you will receive ½ the ad amount as a credit on your statement. Ad sales dates are June 1, 2010 – October 1, 2010. **All ads must be received by October 1, 2010.**

### **Football Mania – (Program Coordinated by Board of Directors)**

Each family will be required to sell 13 tickets. This is a great fundraiser because approximately \$14 of each \$20 ticket sold will go straight to the club to help offset ice fees **and** the top selling players/families will receive prizes (ex: most tickets sold, 1<sup>st</sup> place – ½ off (1) player's fees, 2<sup>nd</sup> place - \$400, 3<sup>rd</sup> place - \$300, 4<sup>th</sup> place - \$200 and 5<sup>th</sup> place \$100).

Here is how the program works: Each ticket contains 3 random teams for each week of the NFL season (a different set of teams each week). Winning tickets are determined based on the total points scored by the teams assigned to that week. Every week, the ticket with the highest combined score wins \$500. There are also other payouts for the 2<sup>nd</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place, as well as payouts for the lowest 2 scores for a total of \$925 paid in prize money per week. In addition, at the end of the season, the ticket with the most points wins \$1000 and the ticket with the lowest total points wins \$275. Additionally, you get 17 weeks of football sweepstakes and free downloads on the FootBallmania Online Library – including digital music, books, and other entertainment items. **Tickets can be sold starting June 10<sup>th</sup> and the bottom stubs have to be returned to the Komets drop box no later than August 25<sup>th</sup>.**

**Reverse Raffle/Golf Outing – Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010 – (Program Coordinated by Bantam Families)**

The Reverse Raffle begins at 6:30 pm following the Golf Outing. Each family's account will be charged for one \$100 Reverse Raffle ticket at the time of registration. This ticket gives you dinner for 2 and also enters you for a chance to win the \$8,000 grand prize. Additional dinner-only tickets can be purchased for \$15 each. Tickets will be automatically assigned to the skater's family's name at the time of registration (and will remain under that name) unless the club is contacted to assign to a different name to the ticket. You have the right to sell this ticket and keep the proceeds. Extra raffle tickets will be available for \$100 each (includes dinner for 2) by contacting Jim Schaeve at [vp-off-ice@kenoshakomets.com](mailto:vp-off-ice@kenoshakomets.com).

The annual Reverse Raffle Dinner and Golf Outing will be held at the Twin Lakes Country Club again this year. The Golf Outing begins at noon. The cost for the golf outing is \$60 per player which includes 18 holes, cart, lunch, drink ticket and gift bag (dinner not included unless raffle ticket is purchased).

**Hoops Mania – January, 2011 – (Program Coordinated by Board of Directors)**

Each family will be required to sell 7 tickets. Again, this is a great fundraiser because approximately \$14 of each \$20 ticket sold will go straight to the club to help offset ice fees.

This is how the program works: each ticket holder is automatically entered into 3 separate contests.

Contest #1 and #2 – each ticket is assigned 5 random teams (represented by their tournament seed numbers) playing in college basketball's national championship tournament. Prizes are awarded at the end of the tournament to the tickets whose teams score the most and fewest combined total points in each contest. If two tickets are tied with the same score, then total combined free throws made will be used as the primary tiebreaker. The more free throws made, the higher the score.

Contest #3 – ticket holders try to match the championship game's final score with the two numbers that are randomly assigned to their ticket. The winning tickets will match both winning and losing numbers in the final score.

Through out the sweepstakes, participants can track the progress of their ticket online to see if they've won any prizes. HoopsMania ticket holders have (16) chances to win a prize in each of the first two contests and (1) chance to win in the third contest.

**Coaches vs. Varsity Game – Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup> 2011 – (Program Coordinated by Midget Major and Minor Families)**

The 5<sup>th</sup> annual Coaches vs Varsity Fundraising game is set for Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Come watch the Komets top boys team (Varsity) face off against the top coaching talents. Tickets are \$20 for family in advance, \$22 at the door – or \$5 individual in advance, \$7 individual at the door. Tickets sold at [www.kenoshakomets.com](http://www.kenoshakomets.com). This event brings in income to the club through ticket sales, raffles and donations.
