

KENOSHA KOMETS 2009-2010 FUNDRAISING

The KBLHC Board of Directors has set a fundraising goal of \$55,000.00 for the 2009-2010 season. The \$55,000.00 is needed to supplement the established 2009-2010 ice fee rates. Each level of play will be assigned a specific fundraising event in which all players/families at that level are required to volunteer and participate in the organization of their event.

Komet Ad Book [Peewee]

Each family is required to sell the equivalent of 1 full page ad; the monetary amount is equal to \$500. By obtaining at least 1 full page (OR ¼ pages, or ½ pages to make up a full page) your \$100 post dated volunteer check will be returned at the end of the season **AND** your skater will receive a \$250 credit to his/her account. If you sell less than the equivalent of a full page ad, your \$100 check will be kept and deposited. For every ad sold, you will receive ½ the ad amount as a credit on your statement. Ad sales dates are June 1st, 2009 – October 1st, 2009. All ads must be received by October 1st, 2009.

Pat McCurdy Concert – August 14th, 2009 – 7:00pm [Board of Directors]

This new event will be held at the UAW Hall (3615 Washington Road; Kenosha, WI 53144). Pat McCurdy is a singer/songwriter/comedian who performs with an unusual off-beat sense of humor. The majority of all proceeds from this event will go directly to the Komets.

Reverse Raffle Dinner / Golf Outing – October 17th, 2009 [Bantams]
